

# OPTIONS FOR FAMILIES

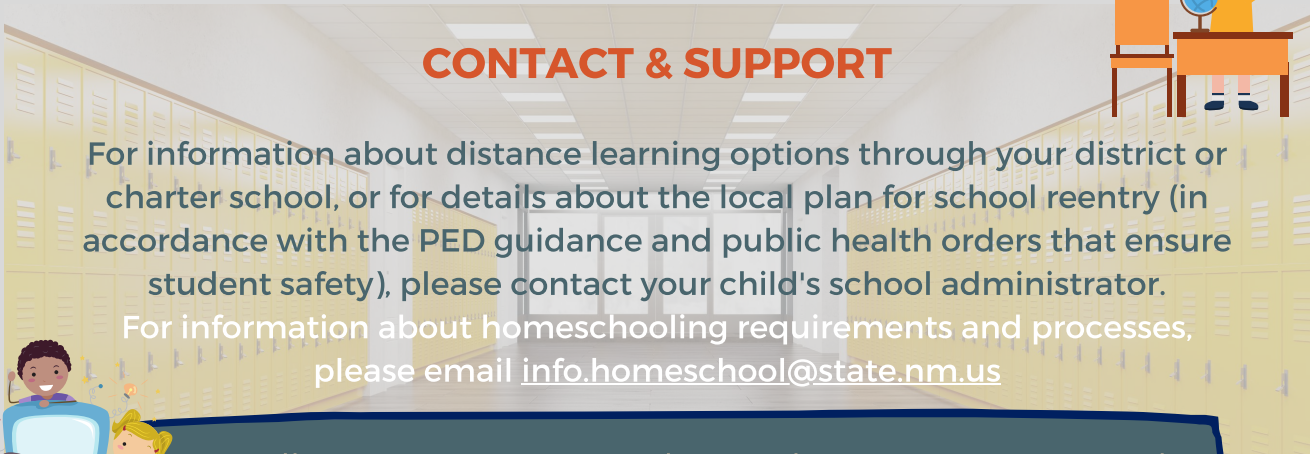
30% of families across New Mexico have shared that they aren't comfortable sending their child back to in-person learning this fall. Here are some options to consider in navigating your child's education during a global pandemic...



All public school districts and charter schools are required to offer a 100% remote learning option throughout the '20-'21 school year for any families who prefer this option. Students continue to have access to educational materials, curriculum, and special education services, if eligible. Parents **do not need to register as a home school.**



Home school operators are solely **responsible for all aspects of instruction for their children.** This requires you to dis-enroll from the existing school(s), create an account online to notify the New Mexico Public Education Department (NMPED) that you intend to operate a home school, and enroll your child(ren).
