WHCS Academic Goals, Grades and Expectations

We have followed the New Mexico Public Education Department's time limits for daily learning. Courses will now focus on essential lessons, so that the scholars can continue to build on this year and be prepared for next year.

Rather than simply utilizing a Pass/Fail model we still want to challenge and reward our student's commitment to their educational outcomes. Therefore we will utilize an additional 10 point (daily) scale. The breakdown is as follows:

- 10 points will be earned by attending class and extra effort/quality. We prefer that the students meet at the scheduled time. If a class is missed (due to scheduling/home/social-emotional concerns, religious/traditional responsibilities), the student can do a check-in during the instructor internet hours to make a plan for making up the lesson. This will still count for the 10 points, but is only to be used as needed, not as a routine. This allows flexibility and accommodations based on what they can do in a given daily context.
- Assignments: Assignments must be completed. Each WHCS Instructor will provide directions
 as to how they want your student to turn in assignments. Please check your e-mail, google
 classroom and/or directions on hard copy packets.
- **Fridays Tutoring Support:** Will help your student be successful. The goals are academic progress, connection and collaboration between WHCS Faculty and Students. Please check in with the WHCS Instructors if you miss an activity/assignment.
- Attendance: WHCS Instructors will take attendance on a daily basis, and we hope that you can be in your Google Class Room during the scheduled time. If you cannot make the scheduled session, please check in with your instructor when you are able.

Contact: We know how difficult this time is, but we want you to know that you can rely on WHCS faculty and staff to provide support, encouragement, and connection with everyone in our WHCS Family.
